# Dr. Brock Rondeau Early Treatment / TMD Therapy

September 12 - 13, 2025 Sheraton, Bradley Airport, Windsor Locks, CT

Dr. Brock Rondeau is the past president and master senior certified instructor for the International Association for Orthodontics. Over 24,000 dentists have attended his courses and study clubs internationally. His practice is limited to the treatment of patients with orthodontic, orthopedic, TMD, and snoring and sleep apnea problems. Dr. Rondeau is a Diplomate of the International Board of Orthodontics, and Diplomate in the American Academy of Craniofacial Pain, Diplomate in the American Academy of Dental Sleep Medicine. He has published over 30 articles in orthodontic and dental journals and has produced internet courses in Orthodontics, TMD and Snoring and Sleep Apnea. His new textbook on Early Orthodontic Treatment for Children is now available.

## Friday, Early Treatment using Fixed and Removable Functional Appliances

Early malocclusions left untreated will worsen over time. Early treatment has been proven to both reduce the cost and time of fixed braces. Parents and children prefer non-extraction and non-surgical treatment. When orthodontic-orthopedic treatment is initiated early the need for extractions of permanent teeth and surgical corrections of the malocclusion is eliminated in 95% of the cases. It has been estimated that as many as 70% of children have some form of malocclusion and yet the majority of orthodontic clinicians are choosing not to treat these patients. This is an excellent opportunity for general dentists to learn how to help these patients and at the same time increase their practice income with Two-Phase Treatment.

- Phase One Orthopedic Phase Mixed dentition (Age 5-11)
  - Functional appliances Non-Extraction, Elimination of functional and skeletal problems
  - 90% of the face is developed by age 12. If you want to modify the growth of children while they are actively growing you must use functional appliances.
- Phase Two Orthodontic Phase Permanent dentition (Age 12-14)
  - Fixed braces to solve dental problems such as crooked teeth and to close spaces

CLINICAL CASES: posterior crossbites, anterior crossbites, deep overbites, anterior open bite, thumb sucking, underdeveloped mandibles, class II malocclusions, class III malocclusions

## Saturday, Diagnosis and Treatment of TM Dysfunction

- Phase I TMJ Stabilization
  - Internal Derangement: Clicking, Locking
    - Mandibular indexed repositioning splint daytime
  - <u>External Derangement</u>: Clenching and grinding
    - Upper anterior deprogrammer, nighttime only
- Phase II Orthodontic Case Finishing
  - Cases will be shown on how to go from Phase I to Phase II.
  - Cases will be shown using fixed braces and clear aligners.

<u>Course Breakdown</u>: Since many of our members attend various portions of the weekend on an individual basis the following protocol has been developed to allow the allocation of credits to accurately reflect seminar attendance.

<u>Case Diagnosis</u>: At the heart of our organization has been the evaluation of each other's cases to enhance clinical skills. Accurate records serve as a basis for accurate orthodontic case diagnosis by each dental practitioner. Orthodontic records include:

- 1. trimmed orthodontic study models,
- 2. accurate photographs with proper retraction (occlusal shots taken with mirrors and flipped for proper display),
- 3. orthodontic clinical exam (includes TMD evaluation),
- 4. panoramic radiograph,
- 5. cephalometric radiograph,
- 6. cephalometric tracing.

The above protocol follows the standard of care for those dental practitioners providing orthodontic services for their patients in the United States. All course attendees are encouraged to bring cases to case diagnosis with the above records so that we may all provide input into each other's cases.
